How the night works

Dear student, parent and/or carer,

Subject presentations will take place at the times listed below in the coloured zone areas, (**please see accompanying school map for details**). All you need do to make your night run smoothly is the following;

• Arrive, register and collect your information packs from the school Atrium, (students will be on hand to guide you).

• Begin by knowing which subjects you wish to see and in which particular order (subjects can be found on the accompanying map).

• Decide on the first subject session you wish to visit (note which colour zone it is in). Upon arrival let us know your first subject and the coloured zone it is in and we will supply a guide to escort you to the appropriate zone and room.
